Dear Dr. Roy,

Thank you for your letter of 31st March last.

As already mentioned, the revised constitution of our organisation will be sent to you as soon as available, i.e. end of July 1984.

It is difficult to establish with precision at this moment the yearly subscription your country would have to pay as this depends on the number of competitors and experts participating in the Osaka competition and is proportionate to the size of your country.

However, we can say that a non-competition year would amount to approx. US \$ 5000, and a competition year approx. US \$ 10'000.-

Travelling and board and lodging expenses for the competition are borne by your country and can be estimated for the Osaka competition in 1985 at approx. US \$ 22 for competitors and approx. US \$ 65 for experts and observers. This price is per person per day, including excursions, receptions, etc. The travelling + board and lodging expenses for your two delegates to the once or twice-yearly committee meetings must also be borne by you.

I have pleasure in enclosing the programme of the coming meetings, to which you are once again cordially invited. As soon as I have your confirmation, I shall send you the agenda and list of proposals. I am convinced this would be an excellent opportunity for you to observe the proceedings of our committees and to clear up any queries you may have. The next meeting is scheduled for February 185, on which occasion India's admission would be possible.
