Dear Sir,

Thank you for your letter of 30th May last and for the interest shown in our organisation. We would indeed welcome your country's future participation in our international vocational training competitions.

Our constitution and official documents are at present under revision. A revised copy will be sent to you coming August.

Towards the end of September next, our member assembly is due for plenary session, which meeting you are cordially invited to attend. For your guidance, a copy of the provisional programme is enclosed.

The annual contributions paid by our members are calculated on the basis of the number of candidates, in relation to the size of the country concerned and the number of inhabitants. I shall be very happy to send you a proposal as soon as the new budget has been drawn up, presumably in September next.

The overall expenses of our organisation are not very high and your country's participation would not exceed US\$ 5000. However, the cost of participating in a competition is borne by the country concerned. For the next competition in Japan, this would amount to US\$ 25 per candidate per day and for accompanying adults, etc., approx US\$ 65 per person per day. Should you be able to participate as a full member in the Australia competition in 1988, the travelling expenses for your team would not be very high.

Our leading committees have two preparatory meetings a year. Each country delegates an official and a technical representative, at its own costs.

I trust that the above information meets your requirements but will be very happy to give further details when the outstanding documents are sent to you.
