Dear Mr. Sommer,

I have examined the accounts for 1992 and have recommended that Ireland's financial commitment of 13,473 S.Fr. be met in full.

I do not anticipate any difficulty in this regard and I will advise you when payment is sanctioned. The total of 13,473 S.Fr. is made up as follows:

(i) Member's Annual Fee (Normal): 6,728 S.Fr.
(ii) Member's Contribution (Additional): 4,300 S.Fr.
(iii) IVTO Information Brochures (1000): 2,445 S.Fr.

I have received your letter detailing the estimated budget for 1993 and Ireland's Membership Fee of 10,292 S.Fr. I was rather surprised at this amount for I understood that the Additional Fee for 1992 was as a result of a once-off expenditure and beyond that the normal fee structure would be re-established taking into account inflation etc. The figure for 1993 appears to take the abnormal year of 1992 as the baseline - see table under.

Membership Fee Year 1989 ----6,752 S.Fr. 1990 -6,235 S.Fr. 1991 -7,302 S.Fr. 1992 \_ 6,728 + 4,300 S.Fr. 1993 ----10,292 S.Fr.

Your letter of 9 June, 1992 re. delegate for IVTO 2000 was delayed and was not received by me until early July. At Thun, I did indicate that Ireland would nominate a representative who would attend the September meeting of IVTO 2000 in Amsterdam.

I regret that it is not possible to arrange for the attendance of a representative on this occasion. This decision is due to an overrun in our foreign travel budget for 1992.
