This is an official application for membership to the I.V.T.O.

The Apprenticeship and Training Council of Bermuda is an officially appointed Government body, constituted under the Apprenticeship and Training Act 1971.

We monitor all training in Bermuda, and certificate successful applicants after examinations, being the only body authorised to do this in Bermuda.

If our application is successful, we agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the I.V.T.O.

I am forwarding by separate mail, 1,007.50 Swiss Francs, as per the phoned request on Tuesday, 18th December, 1984, for entry, until October 1985.

Bermuda is 53 square kilometres and has 55,667 inhabitants.

We intend to enter three competitors (cooking, waiting, electronics) with one expert/chaperone.
