Competition Rules

Dear Jim

Thank you for your fax of 9 February 1998.

I appreciate an addition to our rules on disciplinary matters, including procedures, measures and responsibilities.

I am wondering whether we need in addition to your 9 rules on procedures an article which rules the competency of the body in case of a disqualification of a competitor, expert or any other person from the competition and a rule which protect the organisation against third-party liability.

I think that a Standing Commission (TC or AC) is and should not be empowered for such kind of decisions and that the General Assembly is for practical reasons not the body for a quick decision at the proper moment.

The Executive Board may be the proper body for a decision on disqualification as it is empowered by the Constitution to conduct the Organisation's business (Art. 3.5.) including '... Monitor the quality of the Competition...'.

An article to protect the IVTO against third-party liability is to my opinion necessary as the financial consequences for the Member involved are very high and disqualification is always arbitrary.

What do you think?
