

Official emblem and poster of the 36th WorldSkills Competition

A traditional emblem of Korea, Tae-Guk, and a human hand which is easily associated with skills and techniques configures this official emblem. The basic unit of Tae-Guk is expressed in a vivid touch to notify the traditional culture and skills of Korea. Around the symbol of Tae-Guk, five colors representing skilled persons from five oceans are gathering. Each color used in the symbol has a meaning: yellow stands for harmony, green for youth, blue for advance, red for ambition, orange for friendship.






