WELCOME MESSAGE

JOS DE GOEY, President of WorldSkills Europe

The attention paid to skills has increased a lot in the last decade. Skills competitions show that a career in Vocational, Education and Training can be an excellent option for young people who are looking for a job or have to make a career choice. The global **WorldSkills** competition is organised biannually, in odd-numbered years, alternating with **EuroSkills** in even-numbered year, thus promoting skills annually. For this reason more countries are getting involved: Over 70 countries now participate in WorldSkills. The European version is growing.

EuroSkills aims to show that you can be successful following a skilled career path. Advocating skills as a sound choice and inspiring young people to successfully contribute to society. The biannual **EuroSkills** competition is the European final of national or even regional selections in nearly 30 European countries. Educational institutes, sector organisations, businesses and government are involved on every level. Based on labour market prospects, skills & crafts can be the starting point for a bright future. With the ageing of society, a lot of staff will be needed in some sectors in the near future. **EuroSkills** inspires and informs young people on the possibilities.

WorldSkills France, one of the most active members in the WorldSkills movement, now organising **EuroSkills** 2014 together with the Nord Pas de Calais Region, will inspire other members to further develop their activities in their own countries. Besides using the skills competitions as an example to young people, competitors will raise their level of skills and get a boost in their careers. The more we are able to do so, the better it is for our society. With the French example here in Lille, it is our aim to motivate our members to increase competitions at national level, leading to yet more competitors in Sweden in 2016.

MICHEL GUISEMBERT, President of WorldSkills France

Drawing on over 60 years' experience in the **WorldSkills Competition**, France is bringing the full breadth of its expertise to **EuroSkills** and will be helping young people whose trade is not represented at the **WorldSkills Competition**, and nations who do not participate at global level, to take part in this competition for young Europeans. Further to actions conducted by the organisations involved in the last WorldSkills Competition in response to common European aims for apprenticeship, France is at last realising how important it is for the economy, its competitive edge and employment; as illustrated at the recently-held Grand Conference on Social Cohesion. Given the complexity of trades and their future, it is essential for those who practise them to have extensive general knowledge.

Therefore, all actions enabling this will be assets for these young people. France needs to continue its drive with ambitious projects if we want our country to remain on the leading edge of knowledge and savoir-faire with a global reputation. Thus, drawing on the capacity of **WorldSkills France** to bring together all the stakeholders in professional training in France, we have now filed a dossier with the Prime Minister for the Professional Training of Young People to be recognised as a Grand National Cause for 2015. Catching this momentum, with backing from the French President, confirmed in the Conference on Social Cohesion statement, France will be standing as a candidate in 2015 to host the **WorldSkills Competition** in 2019 in Paris.

CHRISTOPHE PILCH, Vice-President in charge of apprenticeship

It's a first in France! This European competition is a high point of the year, bringing together all partners striving to promote trades and vocational training. Our region invests heavily in young people. This gigantic event is a great opportunity to demonstrate our unwavering determination to offer diverse training courses to young people in the region. A third of the competitors in this European competition are apprentices: this is the time to showcase and make their talents known.

The challenge for us goes beyond the «mere» success of the competition because it is also about breaking down stereotypes and fighting conventional wisdom: no, apprenticeship is not only for people who do not succeed in school or those who do not have an «intellectual» profile!

Apprenticeship is, above all, learning differently, through interaction and concrete application as well as problem solving. It's flourishing in a relationship of trust and accountability with one's tutor, assuming the responsibilities of an employee, keeping commitments and also keeping up with the demanding pace of a triple life: that of an apprentice, a worker and a citizen!

I hope **EuroSkills** will be an opportunity to communicate about all these topics, of course, but also to showcase trades in a lively and interactive manner: better inform to better help guide. We must also be successful at this during these four days of competition.

Beyond that, we will take advantage of the presence of all these European partners to see how we can better mobilise EU funds to facilitate access to training or a solution for all today's discouraged young people lacking direction. That's what the **INITIATIVE For YOUTH EMPLOYMENT** is about. It's a new fund that we will try out from the end of 2014 to offer innovative projects to the far too many dropouts in our region.

I have no doubt that this year's **EuroSkills** will be a total success, thanks to the massive mobilisation of all our regional and national partners to whom I am very grateful!
