- b) Carrier is not liable for damage to passenger or unchecked baggage unless such damage is caused by the negligence
- of carrier.

 c) Carrier is not liable for any damage directly and solely arising out of its compliance with any laws, government
- regulations, orders or requirements, or from failure of passenger to comply with same.

- 5. Checked baggage carried hereunder will be delivered to the bearer of the baggage check upon payment of all unpaid sums due carrier under carrier's contract of carriage or tariff.
- 6. When validated, this ticket is good for carriage from the airport at the place of departure to the airport at the place of destination via the route shown herein and for the applicable class of service and is valid for one year from the date of commencement of flight except as otherwise provided in carrier's tariffs or regulations. Each flight coupon will be accepted for carriage on the date and flight for which accommodations have been reserved; when flight coupon are issued on an "oen of date" basis, accommodations will be reserved upon application subject to availability of space.
- 7. Carrier undertakes to use its best efforts to carry the passenger and baggage with reasonable dispatch, but no particular time is fixed for the commencement or completion of carriage. Subject thereto, carrier may without notice substitute siterate carriers or aircraft and may alter or omit the stopping place shown on the face of the citek it case of necessity. Times shown in timetables or elsewhere are approximate and not guaranteed, and form no part of this contract.
