

VI INTERNATIONAL WORKERS TECHNICAL TRAINING COMPETITION

Since the year 1951 the Delegación Nacional del Frente de Juventudes has been organising the International Workers Technical Training Competitions in Spain. The first two were of an Iberian character (Portugal-Spain) in collaboration with the "Mocidade Portuguesa" Youth Movement. In reality, young workers from Portugal, Switzerland, West Germany, France, England, Ireland, Belgium, Italy and Holland take

This unique Competition is being received each time with greater interest by industrial and teaching centres of many countries for its competitive character and because it provides, for young workers of each nation, a means of understanding and friendship with those of other nations a very effective stimulus for improving their cultural and technical developmen.

In this youth competition of workers from industriel enterprises, or pupils from technical schools, experts in the branches of Metalwork, Woodwork, Electrical Engineering and Construction take part.

The specialised industries of which this competition will be formed are the following. Metalwork, Woodwork, Electrical Engineering, Construction and Other specialised work.

This Competition will be controlled by an Organising Council which will include an official representative and a tecnician from each of the countries participating.

The necessary expenses incurred by the Competition and those that could affect the participants are as follows:

- 1. The cost of the competitor's journey, including fare and indidental expenses, as far as the place where the Competition is to be held will be borne by the respective countries. Likewise for the return journey.
- 2. The costs of maintenance, board and lodging, and general organisation will be borne by the country in which the Competition is held.

The winners will receive prizes (Trophy, Diploma, etc.) and will receive a certificate from the President of the Organising Council which will record their participation and attendance.


In connection with the VI International Workers Technical

Training Competition visits and excursions of an instructive nature will be organised, at times and on days apart from those fixed for the Competition tests.

The Organising Council proposes that the VI International Workers Technical Training Competition take place during the first fifteen days of October, 1957, on the lines of the formes Competitions, and that it will be open to workers between the ages of 15 and 22 years from all countries. Tothis end, therefore, private and official organisations or firms and schools wishing to take part in this Competition will be able to select their teams and representatives freely, taking into account that, for each country, only a single competitor from each specialised trade or category may be allowed.

Competitor may be entered by compelling the enclosed "Boletin de Inscription" (Entry Form) and returning in to the "SECRETARIA DE LOS CONCURSOS INTERNACIO-NALES DE FORMACION PROFESIONAL OBRERA", calle del Marqués de Riscal, n.º 7, MADRID (Spain), before the 1st September, 1957.




