SKILL OLYMPICS

THE Canterbury man who took Britain into the international training competition, the Skill Olympics, has retired.

Mr Fred Hill, of Berry House, 21 Bramley Avenue, has given up as chairman of the Society for the Promotion of Vocational Training and Education, which organises the British entry

The Skill Olympics started in Spain after World War II as a national competition. But, in 1950, it went international and three years later Britain was invited to take part.

Britain did not officially accept the invitation but Mr Hill, who was running Canterbury Craft Centre, heard about it 10 days before it was due to start.

He decided to take his apprentice son to Madrid and, taking his family with him for their summer holiday, drove to Spain.

"I arrived fully expecting to join the British team - only to find that my son and I were the British team," he recalled.

He got no support from the British government but General Franco presented him with a silver medal for his efforts.

When he returned, he again tried to get the government to back a team, but with no success. So, he personally wrote to over 400 firms, outlining the competition's aims.

He maintained that if competition in sport was so popular, so could contests in crafts and industrial skills.

In 1956, he finally managed to get together a six-strong team with the backing of firms.

From then, the competition went from strength to strength, recruiting more countries and expanding the competitive trades until now, when nearly 300 competitors take part

and compete in 33 trades.

Over the last 30 years Mr Hill has seen a shift from award winners coming from Britain, Germany and other Western nations to the Koreans and Japanese scooping all the medals.

This showed their emphasis on high standards, he said. "I feel standards in Britain have declined, although the competition does help to maintain them by matching our young apprentices against those from other countries."

He has spoken abroad at many conferences on youth training and in 1964 was awarded an MBE for his work.

Now in his 70s, Mr Hill plans to keep a close eye on the Skill Olympics and will make sure the British team has the benefit of his advice. But he is also looking forward to a chance to relax.

He will still be in close contact with young people, for he has also been closely associated with the Scout movement throughout his life and is district president.

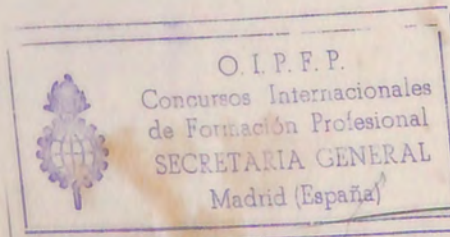
