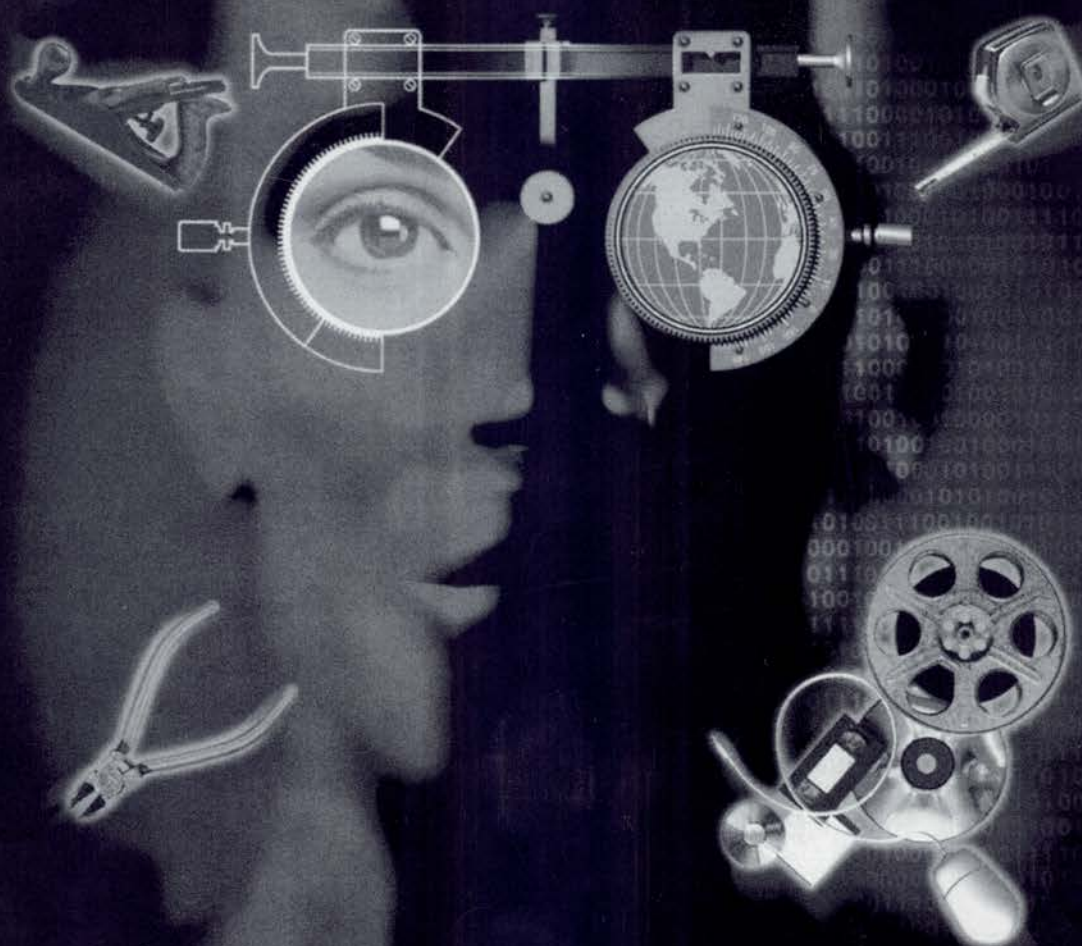

UK SKILLS

UK SKILLS is recognised by the Government as the standard-setting body for skills competitions in the United Kingdom and is promoting the development of a national framework of skills competitions covering every industry sector. It is affiliated to



the International Vocational Training Organisation (IVTO) and organises the British entry to the World Skills Competition (Skill Olympics).

World Skills Competition (Skill Olympics)

The World Skills Competition (Skill Olympics) is held every two years in one of the 30+ IVTO member

countries. Competitions held over four days in 40 occupational skills are open to contestants up to the age of 22. The 1999 event was held in Montreal, 11-14 November. The next one will be held in Seoul, South Korea, in 2001.
