

Instructions for candidates.

- 1st. Consult with the expert of your workshop or with their assistants, where you have to keep your tools, your working clothes and drawings of the exercise which you are doing.
- 2nd. The drawing or plan of the exercise which you are doing must be handed in together with your work at the end of each day's work. This drawing must not be taken out of the workshop. When you have finished your exercise you can take it with you.
- 3rd. The turners and millers will not be able to use files, or polishing materials. The finished part of the work must be handed in as it comes out of the machine.
- 4th. The fitters will not use the scrapers, and it is also forbidden to adjust the parts by incorrect procedures, such as counter-drawing etc.
- 5th. The forgers will not use any other tools than those used in forging and anvil, that is to say they will not use files or tools for smoothing.
- 6th. The moulders and founders will do two exercises: one to observe the quality of moulding and the other to see the quality of the piece obtained.
- 7th. The welders should not start the different phases of the exercises without the authority of the jury; that is to say to continue with the welding upwards after having finished the vertical, the consolidation should be effected.
- 8th. You should claim from Secretariat the amount that will be punctuated for each exercise, and also to have indicated on your drawing or plan the fundamental levels, which the jury will have in mind to qualify.
- 9th. Take care that your exercise is in proper safe keeping between working hours.
- 10th. Once you have finished your exercise, ask for the Secretary of the jury to hand in your finished work.
- 11th. Try not to erase the special marks or numbers which are placed by the experts. If the process of your work demands that these special marks disappear, make it known to the expert so that he can mark them again.
- 12th. During the course of your work you must not speak with persons alien to the Organising Council. You will never start a conversation with your fellow workers while you are doing your exercise.
- 13th. If you have any doubt the interpretation of the design; if you are short of any tool or require some other working instrument ask the representative of the committee or of the experts.
- 14th. If you spoil the material which you have been given, you can ask for same again but once only. This will be taken into account at the time of qualification.
- 15th. To copy intentionally the process in the working of an exercise of another contestant, and also to be lacking in discipline at work, will be a reason for disqualification. You are therefore obliged to obey the rules and resolutions of the Organising Committee in every way.
