A SCOT will be team leader when the British apprentices team goes to Utrecht, Holland, for the International Apprentice Competition from June 18 to 29.

He is Mr. Archibald Sharkie, a member of the teaching staff at Stow College of Engineering in Springburn, who helped to supervise the welfare of visiting teams when the competition was held in Glasgow last year and 11 countries were represented.

Mr. Sharkie tells me that the British team will probably be about 28 strong.

"Final tests are going on now, so it is not yet known how many Scots may be in the team," he said.

The British team established a handsome lead in Glasgow when they won with 9 gold, 5 silver, and 3 bronze awards.
