WELCOME TO FRANCE

The French Republic is a democratic and cosmopolitan country, the third largest in Europe. It welcomes tens of millions of visitors yearly and has repeatedly taken the title of most visited country worldwide. The variety of cultures, landscapes, and traditions across its regions create rich and unique diversity. The country prides itself on its gastronomy, art, culture, fashion, and haute-couture, and lives by the French «art-de-vivre», renowned worldwide for its sophistication and tradition.

France has 49 sites on the UNESCO World Heritage List and 26 elements on the Intangible Heritage list, such as the distinguished gastronomic meal of the French, an established social practice where French people celebrate moments around a festive meal.

From rural and mountainous areas to sunny coastlines, and from forests to big cities, the country is home to many landscapes and has something for everyone.

Nicknamed the Hexagon in reference to its shape, France has a vibrant and extraordinary history and is the country of Kylian Mbappé, Victor Hugo, Charlotte Gainsbourg, Omar Sy, Edith Piaf, Charles de Gaulle, Thomas Pesquet, Marie Curie, and many others. The country values history and culture and has a network of around 1,220 museums, with 61 museums dedicated to holding, preserving, and promoting national collections of art, culture, science, and technology.

LYON

The city of Lyon is honoured to host the 47th WorldSkills Competition, almost 30 years after hosting the first WorldSkills Competition held in France, in October 1995.

Located in the centre-east of France at the confluence of the Rhône and Saône rivers, Lyon is home to more than half a million people. The dynamic city regularly hosts international events and overflows with a cultural and historical richness that attracts millions of tourists every year.

Lyon was awarded 19th place in Time Out magazine's list of the 53 best cities in the world and has consistently been ranked as one of the country's best cities for students, with several campuses and an established community of international students. The city has all it takes to make the 47th WorldSkills Competition a unique and memorable event.

In addition to being the birthplace of cinematography and one of the world's best capital of gastronomy, Lyon is home to architectural and historical masterpieces, and the historic city centre has been a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1998.

The city of Lyon is a unique mix of cultural and architectural heritage, with a vibrant economic scene, iconic sites, and high-standard venues.

It is easily accessible, with numerous direct flights to and from the Lyon Saint Exupéry International Airport, as well as three main train stations.

WORLDSKILLS LYON 2024

The 47th WorldSkills Competition will take place in Lyon, France, from 10 to 15 September 2024, bringing together 1,400 Competitors from 70 countries and regions to compete in 62 skills.

The event will be a unique opportunity to promote skills, encourage the development of young people within vocational training, and create future generations of skilled talent who will be essential in meeting tomorrow's challenges.

WorldSkills Lyon 2024 will welcome 250,000 visitors, including students, international delegations, families, professionals in search of future employees, young people interested in vocational training, people looking to retrain, and many others.

Launched in October 2021, the WorldSkills Lyon 2024 Competition Organizer is the ephemeral entity created and designated to deliver the WorldSkills Competition in 2024, with WorldSkills International defining the criteria for organization, quality, and governing the Competition.

The WorldSkills Lyon 2024 Competition Organizer also works in coordination with WorldSkills France, which carries and represents the WorldSkills movement in France, and is responsible for organizing the WorldSkills France National Finals, as well as selecting and preparing the National Team.

Our goal is to build a real-life platform for the promotion of skill competitions and vocational education and training by:

- ◆ Inspiring pride in young people to practice a skill with excellence.
- ◆ Creating an innovative visitor experience to lead young people to Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) careers.
- ◆ Prioritizing sustainability, social, and environmental responsibilities to reduce our footprint and promoting diversity and inclusion.



WorldSkills Lyon 2024 will carry our core values onto the international stage which are:

EXCELLENCE

As a driver for success through personal development.

GENEROSITY

We want to make WorldSkills Lyon 2024 an experience of sharing and conviviality, bringing together Competitors, organizers, visitors, and all those building stronger TVET systems.

OPENNESS

As a source of inspiration to make WorldSkills Lyon 2024 a symbol of diversity and inclusion for all.

UNITY

As a tool to rally supporters and Competitors from all over the world around the same ambition: to promote the power of skills.

The WorldSkills Lyon 2024 Competition Organizer is committed to raising the profile of TVET, strengthening the skills of young people at an international level, and improving global standards of skills and excellence.

WorldSkills Lyon 2024 will be the second international WorldSkills Competition organized in France. The first one was organized in 1995, and also took place in Lyon. In 1953, France participated for the first time in a WorldSkills Competition in Madrid, Spain.



WORLDSKILLS FRANCE

WorldSkills France is a non-profit organization founded in the aftermath of the Second World War, with the aim of promoting skills for all through competitions that showcase the passion and savoir faire of young people.

WorldSkills France coordinates the regional selection process and organizes the national competition which results in the formation of the French National Team.

This team is made up of the best young people in over sixty skills. Members of the French Skills Team take part in international competitions: EuroSkills on a European scale and the WorldSkills Competition on a global scale.

WorldSkills France is also in charge of the physical and mental preparation of each young French Competitor, who benefits from a unique ecosystem enabling them to reach their best level. They can count on an Expert to advise and support them throughout their career, they can train in a Centre of Excellence, and they can also count on the investment of their training centre and often their employer.

WorldSkills France relies on a wide network of:

- ◆ Volunteers, Experts, Workshop Managers, Technical Supervisors, Team Leaders, Ambassadors.
It's a rich ecosystem of over 7,000 people.
- ◆ Centres of Excellence where young Competitors can train.
- ◆ Institutional and private partners.

WorldSkills France collaborates with the Abilympics France association, to highlight skills of candidates with disabilities, regardless of their age. Competitions are open to people with disabilities to reveal their aptitudes and professional skills, beyond their disability, and in an effort to promote inclusion and professional integration.

To ensure safe and comfortable conditions for all accredited individuals, it is recommended to:

Follow safety signs and instructions throughout the visit to the competition venue;

- ◆ Be attentive to vehicles when exiting buildings;
- ◆ Exercise caution when moving through passages, on stairs, escalators, and uneven surfaces;
- ◆ Immediately inform representatives of WorldSkills Lyon 2024 or security services if you discover any danger or violation that could cause injury or an emergency situation.

Smoking is only permitted in designated areas outside the competition venue.

In case of an emergency

In case of an emergency, you must follow the instructions provided by the Workshop Manager (within the skill) or the security officer. If you hear the evacuation alarm, please:

- ◆ Remain calm, do not panic;
- ◆ Exit the area using the nearest and safest evacuation routes, using unlocked doors, following evacuation signs with green arrows and the word EXIT, and ensuring not to obstruct others.



- ◆ Do not enter the traffic area, do not obstruct access to special equipment, and only move on the sidewalk;
- ◆ Proceed to the assembly point and stay with your group until the security officer informs you that there is no danger and you may return or leave the premises;
- ◆ Do not re-enter the hazardous area for any reason;
- ◆ Assist those who are weak or injured.

In each workshop area: In case of minor injuries, first aid kits are available and COVID-19 prevention kits are also provided.

For general public: In the event of illness or injury, paramedics will be present in all halls of Eurexpo Lyon. A medical team is available in the venue infirmary.

Mandatory signs

1. Personal Protective Equipment

At Eurexpo Lyon, specific Personal Protective Equipment will be required to enter each workshop. Workshops with hazardous and harmful production factors will be equipped with signs indicating the necessary Personal Protective Equipment.

2. Sustainability

To comply with the regulations in force, and to apply to the WorldSkills Lyon 2024 Organizer

Sustainability Strategy, please sort your waste according to the signs and indications on waste devices that you will find on sites.

Accessibility for people with disabilities

You will find reception desks and special facilities at the Competition and Ceremonies venues to ensure that people with disabilities feel welcome.

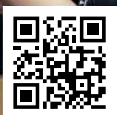
ONE SCHOOL ONE COUNTRY

One School One Country (OSOC) is a programme encouraging cultural exchange between international Competitors and students in the host city, Lyon, while promoting skilled careers represented at the Competition. Launched in 2007 by WorldSkills Shizuoka 2007, the programme is an opportunity for local students and teachers of the host city to learn about different cultures, skills and options in TVET. On 10 September 2024, more than 5,000 students from 52 schools across Lyon and the surrounding areas will participate and welcome 1,400 visiting Competitors to their school.

On arriving at the school, the OSOC day typically begins with a warm welcome from students and educators, a short presentation of the school and introduction by the delegation, and includes various games and activities highlighting the local culture and that of the delegation. The visit wraps up with an informal exchange where students can ask Competitors different questions about their skills and Competitor journey, and a group photo.

Competitors will participate in cultural activities and interact with local youth, while students will learn about their attributed delegation's culture and meet young, skilled professionals in a variety of careers. Offering a moment of appreciation and recognition, One School One Country provides Competitors with great inspiration before the Competition begins. Following the OSOC day, from 11 to 13 September 2024, schools participating in the One School One Country programme will visit the Competition to see Competitors in action.

As part of WorldSkills Lyon 2024, a number of activities will be offered to visitors within special Try-a-Skill zones. 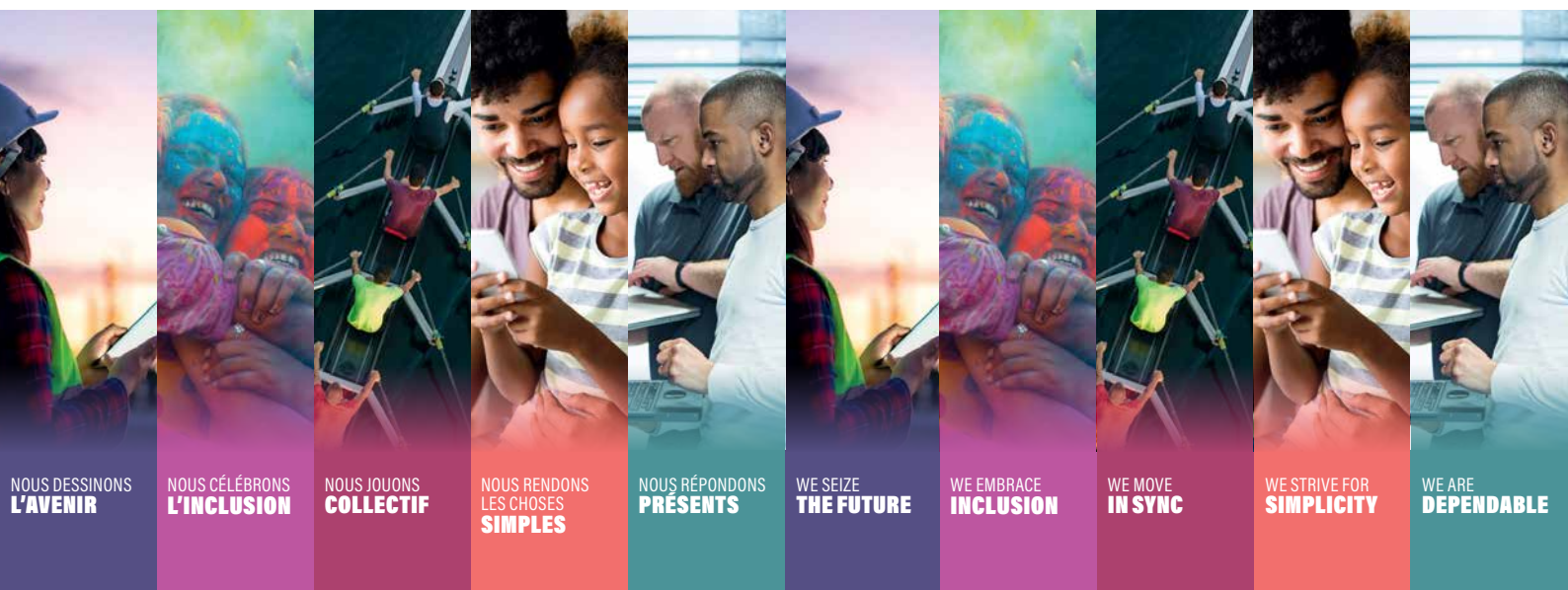
VISITOR EXPERIENCE ZONES

The goal of Visitor Experience is to offer an experience that matches the needs of each population: dedicated pathways, content, and tools.

The Objectives of the Visitor Experience are :

- ◆ To put the skills promotion at the heart of the experience from the beginning to the end of the visit
- ◆ To give consistency and offer the best comprehension possible of the Competition and the skills practices in real-life
- ◆ Finally, the visitor experience open the doors of the Competition to those who can't physically attend the Competition through a strong digital content strategy: an immersive experience.

Several areas of the Eurexpo site will be dedicated to the visitor experience. COMPETITOR EXPERIENCE

The objective of the Competitor Experience Team is to ensure that every Competitor has an exceptional experience during their stay in Lyon, prioritizing their physical and mental well-being throughout the Competition.

As part of this, the Competitor Experience team has set up areas dedicated to rest and recharge during the Competition. These areas are designed to reduce stress and promote equity by offering equal access to facilities. These facilities help Competitors perform better and enable them to interact with each other, forge friendships, and share their experiences in a safe environment.

Team Leaders will have access to this zone, however, please note that this space is dedicated to Competitors' physical and mental well-being. It has been designed for Competitors to relax, rest, and have fun. This is not a space for Team Leaders to host team meetings.



ACCOMMODATION

WorldSkills Lyon 2024 has a large number of official hotels in the city of Lyon and its suburbs to accommodate accredited guests during their visit.

Participants will be accommodated in a selection of 90 hotels ranging from 2** to 5***** stars, depending on the package category booked.

In view of the number of participating Members and the size of the various delegations, you may be staying in the same hotel as another WorldSkills Member.

Hotels will provide single and twin accommodation as well as breakfast for all participants. The length of stay is determined in the package purchased.

Rooms availability:

Rooms are available **from 16:00** on the day of arrival, regardless of the time of arrival and the means of transportation used and must be vacated **by 11:00** on the day of departure, regardless of the time of arrival and the means of transportation used.

Early check-in and late check-out may incur additional costs that the participant must pay on site.

Food and beverage in your accommodation

Breakfast is included in all packages, and is served at the hotels.

The breakfast times will be communicated to you by reception on check-in.

WorldSkills Lyon 2024 does not provide other meals in your accommodation.

Extras and/or room damage

Apart from accommodation and breakfast, any other service requested at the hotel will be invoiced and paid for on-site by the participant.

Any damage caused will also be invoiced and paid for by the participant.

To guarantee payment of supplements or any damage to the room, you will be asked to provide a credit card imprint.

Taking an «imprint» means putting your credit card information on file while check-in so that if you use the minibar, order room service or damage furniture, the hotel can charge the cost to your card.

We recommend identifying one person in your group to take responsibility for this and informing your hotel of their name in advance.

Please ensure the credit card is accepted in Europe and by the hotel. If you are unable to provide a credit card imprint, it is essential that you contact the hotel in advance to discuss possible alternatives, such as a cheque, cash deposit, or bank transfer.

The Hotel Description card with contact details is located **in the Documents section** in the WSL2024 package system.

Accompanying persons

If someone comes with you during your stay, they must directly check in at the hotel and WorldSkills Lyon 2024 will not be held responsible for any costs incurred by them.

TRANSPORTATION

WorldSkills Lyon 2024 has developed a transportation system for all participants who have selected a package including transportation. This system is organized based on service levels, taking into account the location of the hotels. At the event venues (Eurexpo, OL Vallée), pick-up and drop-off zones will be designated for each type of transportation, ensuring efficient management of traffic flow. Information regarding your pick-up and drop-off zones at each official site will be communicated to you, and on-site guidance will be provided by our team of volunteers.

SERVICE LEVEL

Service levels are determined based on hotel locations, role, and arrival times on site and was worked out according to schedules and traffic flow.

As a reminder, the transport service is only available to participants who have purchased packages.

Service level definition

- ◆ **Dedicated bus:** Bus allocated to a group for transfers between hotels (by cluster) and official sites at scheduled times.
- ◆ **Group buses:** Sharing a bus among multiple hotels and on multiple rotations (shuttles) to official sites (Eurexpo, OL Vallée, Airport, and train station).
- ◆ **Hybrid system:** Combination of public transportation and WSL2024 shuttles between designated hubs and official sites (Eurexpo, OL Vallée), except for the closing ceremony and arrivals/departures.
- ◆ **Public transportation:** Use of public transportation for all journeys, except for the closing ceremony and arrivals/departures.








Daily transfers

A precise transportation plan, based on service levels of populations and hotel locations, allows each participant to reach the Competition Venue at Eurexpo every day.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Arrival:

The official points of arrival and departure for the WorldSkills Lyon 2024 participants are :

- ◆ Part Dieu Train Station (XYD)
- ◆ Saint Exupéry Airport (LYS)
- ◆ Saint Exupéry Train Station (LYS)

At these ports of entry, our team will be there to welcome, register, and guide you to the transportation (group buses) that will take you to your hotel. 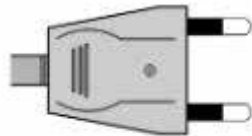

In France, **shops open around 09:00 and close around 19:30**. They aren't open on Sundays (except for some stores).

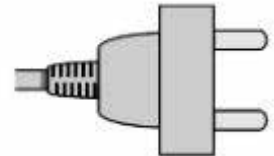
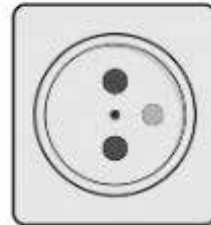

DOs and DON'Ts

DOs:

In the Competition venue / regarding the Competition:

- ◆ Behave respectfully towards others / Support and encourage the different teams.

- ◆ Offer a seat in public transport: Make sure to offer your seat to a person with disabilities, pregnant women, or an elderly person.
- ◆ "Vouvoiement": when you speak to someone you don't know and talk in French, you have to use "vous" instead of "tu". It is a form of politeness.

DON'Ts:

In the Competition Venue / regarding the Competition:

- ◆ Display any signs or symbols that aim at inciting racial or religious strife.
- ◆ Throw any object or liquid of any kind in the direction of participants, visitors, law enforcement and staff.
- ◆ Attend the venue under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or toxic substances.

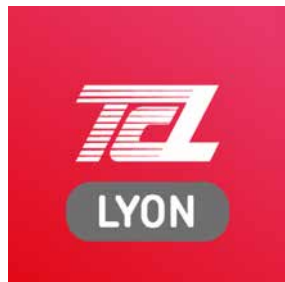
In the City Centre:

- ◆ Put your money in your back pocket: Lyon is a big city where there can be pickpockets. In public transportation, be careful with your belongings. In the streets, be careful where you put your money. Back pockets are easy to reach, please make sure to put it somewhere safer and less reachable.
- ◆ Throw your cigarette on the ground: according to the law, this action attracts a fine of €350. The city is provided with street garbage cans with ashtrays.
- ◆ Urinate in the street: this action is punishable by the law with a €400 fine. You can find public toilets in the city.
- ◆ Walk down the street while being drunk: this action is dangerous for both you and other people. You can be caught by the police and taken to the police station, where you will be put in a cell to sober up. To avoid this situation, drink with moderation and call a cab to take you back to your hotel.

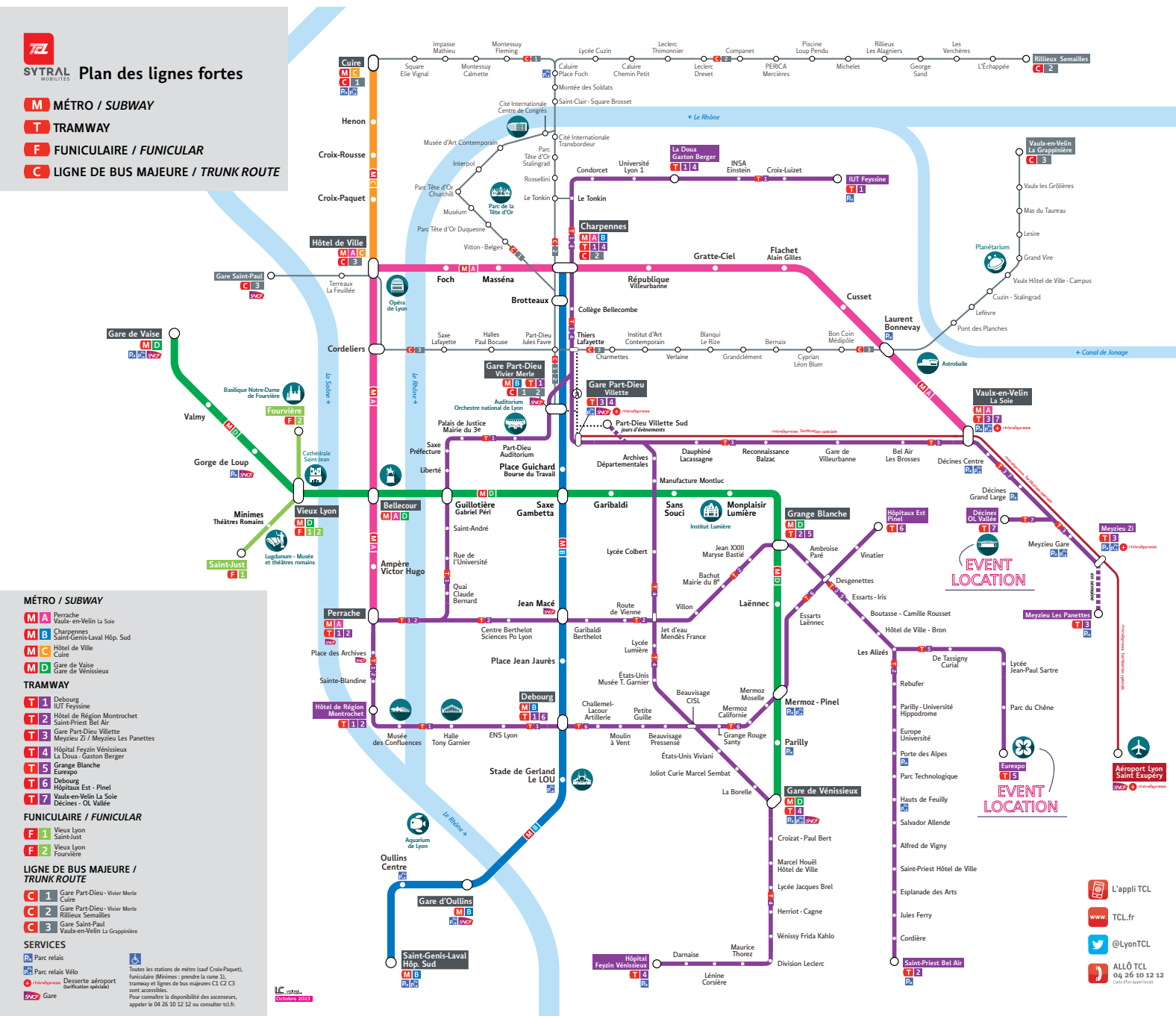
Public Transport

To avoid carbon emissions, please prioritize taking public transport, cycling, or walking. Lyon city has an extended public transport network.

Subway, buses and tramway



Lyon's public transport network is run by TCL. There are 4 metro lines, 6 tram lines, 2 funiculars, and lots of buses. A single ticket cost €2.00 and can be used for any mode of public transport for one hour. Tickets can be purchased from TCL machine's, located at all metro stations or tram stations. You can also purchase a ticket in buses (€2.30). The TCL service offers you the possibility of using your contactless credit card as a ticket.





Lyon by bike.

To borrow a bike quickly and cheaply, you can order the bikes "Velo'v". They are easily identifiable in orange and deployed throughout the city and many cycle paths are available in Lyon.

Velo'v is a self-service bicycle system. Bikes can be rented at any of the 428 stations in the city and are easily recognizable by their red colour. A single ride ticket costs €1.80, with the first 30 min free. You can also purchase a Velo'v day pass at €4.00 that allows you to take any Velo'v bicycles for 24 hours.

Please note that Over 12 years of age, it is not compulsory to wear a helmet when cycling, but it is strongly recommended.

If you drive at night, make sure you have a high-visibility vest and functional lighting.

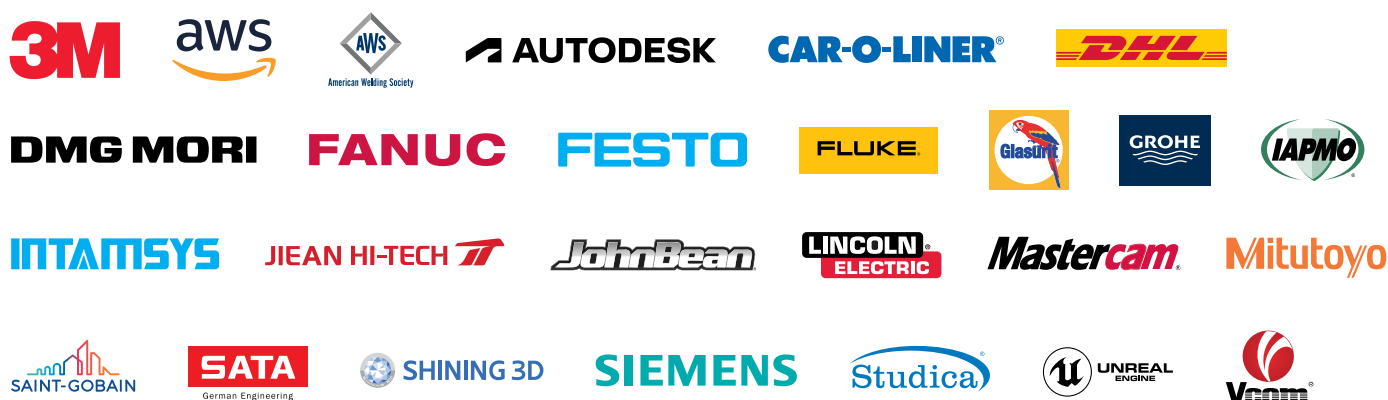
